

Chlortetracycline Beef Cattle Feed – BP – CMX^a

Type C Medicated Complete Feed
(chlortetracycline Type C medicated feed)

For the control of bacterial pneumonia associated with shipping fever complex caused by *Pasteurella spp.* susceptible to chlortetracycline in beef cattle.
